The Three Heaven and Earth Ages

Court is in Session.

I present before this Court my proposition that the Scriptures describe three Ages. I shall draw from the King James Version for ease of reference; yet, when necessary we will go to the manuscripts so that we can see. Understand Reader that the King James Version is just that – a Version. The KJV is a translation of the Masoretic and Suptuagint Texts; therefore, when it becomes necessary I shall return to the Texts to shed light on what is possible and let us decide if the translation is appropriate or not.

Specifically, by Ages, I do not mean houses of the Sun as I do not go for the Mystery Religions. The Age that I speak of is defined as the Age [time].

Furthermore, Reader if I make a Statement I will back it up in Scripture. I shall not leave you wanting for evidence. Also for your edification the word LORD is not in the manuscripts – it is Yehovah. I shall refer to Jesus as Yehoshuah. As the "J" is only five hundred +/- years old so Jesus cannot be the name of the Messiah.

Therefore before we begin let us go to foundational required knowledge of the Greek and the Hebrew.

From <u>G2596</u> and <u>G906</u>; to *throw down:* - cast down, lay.

In the Hebrew the destruction of the First Age is known as Tuhu va Bohoo

Let us begin by going to Scripture and realizing that Yehovah does not create anything void and empty.

Isa 45:18 For thus saith the LORD that created the heavens; God himself that formed the earth and made it; he hath established it, **he created it not in vain**, he formed it to be inhabited: I *am* the LORD; and *there is* none else.

Let us explore this words "not" and "vain". Both of these words are not "filler" words; they are both in the manuscripts.

From an unused root meaning **to lie** *waste*; a *desolation* (of surface), that is, *desert*; figuratively a *worthless* thing; adverbially in *vain*: - confusion, empty place, without form, nothing, (thing of) nought, vain, vanity, waste, wilderness.

Therefore we have it straight from Yehovah's Word that he created the Earth not in waste but to be inhabited. And so Yehovah did it.

Now, let us proceed to Psalm 104 – Yehovah be blessed.

Psa 104:1 Bless the LORD, O my soul. O LORD my God, thou art very great; thou art clothed with honour and majesty.

Psa 104:2 Who coverest *thyself* with light as *with* a garment: who stretchest out the heavens like a curtain:

Psa 104:3 Who layeth the beams of his chambers in the waters: who maketh the clouds his chariot: who walketh upon the wings of the wind:

Tangent: There is very deep meaning in this verse 104:3; but it is not for this topic.

Psa 104:4 Who maketh his angels spirits; his ministers a flaming fire:

Psa 104:5 *Who* laid the foundations of the earth, *that* it should not be removed for ever.

Commentary: The Earth is where we will be for-ever and ever. We are not flying away in some sort of crazy Rapture. Rapture is something we shall address soon.

Psa 104:6 Thou coveredst it with the deep as *with* a garment: the waters stood above the mountains.

Commentary: Did you see that? There are no seas in the first Age as there are no Seas in the third age. This is the firmament that protected the Earth as a a garment. Very eloquent.

Psa 104:7 At thy rebuke they fled; at the voice of thy thunder they hasted away.

Commentary: Okay it is time to get moving. Look at that at thy rebuke "they" fled. What fled? The water. Just so the reader can get up to speed in case the reader thinks this is Noah's flood, it took OVER one whole year for Noah's flood waters to flee. No these waters hasted away – the writer implies they Ran Immediately away.

So as not to leave you wanting in regard to Noah's flood. Mark this date for those who want to pay close attention to Father's Word:

Gen 7:11 In the six hundredth year of Noah's life, in the second month, the

seventeenth day of the month, the same day were all the fountains of the great deep broken up, and the windows of heaven were opened.

Gen 8:13 And it came to pass in the six hundredth and first year, in the first month, the first day of the month, the waters were dried up from off the earth: and Noah removed the covering of the ark, and looked, and, behold, the face of the ground was dry.

Commentary: Time: 601st year, 2nd month, 27th day - 600th year, 2nd month, 17th day.

<u>Is to tell this scholar of God's Word that Noah was on that Ark for 1 year and ten days.</u>

But here we find the waters fled instantly.

Psa 104:8 They go up by the mountains; they go down by the valleys unto the place which thou hast founded for them.

Psa 104:9 Thou hast set a bound that they may not pass over; that they turn not again to cover the earth.

Commentary: And so it is the ocean shore and the rivers and the stream boundaries were established.

Now the Word claims that some men and women "willingly choose to be ignorant of the Ages". Let us Go there now. But before we go there realize again what just happened in Psalm 104 is NOT Noah's flood. So we are talking about something much, much greater than Noah's flood.

2Pe 3:1 This second epistle, beloved, I now write unto you; in *both* which I stir up your pure minds by way of remembrance:

Commentary: "Of Remembrance" of what? Peter is about to speak to the mystery of the Ages.

2Pe 3:2 That ye may be mindful of the words which were spoken before by the holy prophets, and of the commandment of us the apostles of the Lord and Saviour:

Commentary: Peter is saying he look reader we got this directly from Yehoshuah. So pay attention.

2Pe 3:3 Knowing this first, that there shall come in the last days scoffers, walking after their own lusts,

Commentary: Well that is just about as plain as it gets. Look around many claim, there is no God. That shall grow increasingly worse. So be it.

2Pe 3:4 And saying, Where is the promise of his coming? for since the fathers fell asleep, all things continue as *they were* from the beginning of the creation.

Commentary: This will grow a lot worse.

2Pe 3:5 For this **they willingly are ignorant of**, that by the word of God **the heavens were of old**, and the **earth standing out of the water and in the water**:

Commentary: First Age: The heavens were of old. And remember Psalm 104:6 and that "firmament" that hovered over the Earth. And look at that the earth standing out of the water – no SEAS. But yet in the water – surrounded by the "Firmament".

2Pe 3:6 Whereby the world that then was, being overflowed with water, perished:

Commentary: This is not Noah's flood friend. Have you forgotten Psalm 104 yet. We are going to get a second witness shortly; but for now Psalm 104 shall serve as the first witness.

This is the point of complete destruction of the first Age. The Katabole and the Tuhu va Buhoo

2Pe 3:7 But the <u>heavens and the earth</u>, <u>which are now</u>, by the same word are kept in store, reserved unto fire against the day of judgment and perdition of ungodly men.

Commentary: Heaven's and the Earth. Noah's flood did not reach the Heavens friend. Which are now. 2nd Age.

2Pe 3:8 But, beloved, be not ignorant of this one thing, that one day *is* with the Lord as a thousand years, and a thousand years as one day.

Commentary: Eth ha aw dawm (The Man) did in fact die in the day that he partook of the fruit - he did not make 1000 years.

2Pe 3:9 The Lord is not slack concerning his promise, as some men count slackness; but is longsuffering to us-ward, not willing that any should perish, <u>but that all should come to repentance</u>.

Commentary: This is the reason for this age. While this is what Yehovah desires he knows he has given mankind free will so in fact not all will in fact come to repentance.

2Pe 3:12 Looking for and hasting unto the coming of the day of God, wherein the heavens being on fire shall be dissolved, and the elements shall melt with fervent heat?

Commentary: verse 12 scares most Christians but if they comprehend the Greek then they have nothing to worry about. I'm not going to do all the work. Hint: Elements

2Pe 3:13 Nevertheless we, according to his promise, look for new heavens and a new earth, wherein dwelleth righteousness.

Commentary: 3rd Age. New Heavens and New Earth. Rather re-newed. How many decks on that Ark friend? THREE.

2Pe 3:15 And account *that* the longsuffering of our Lord *is* salvation; even as our beloved brother Paul also according to the wisdom given unto him hath written unto you;

Commentary: Paul had three commissions and most times the levels to the Kings/Queens and the Elect is just to above the average readers head so they dismiss Paul. Paul was a Hebrew Scholar amongst Scholars.

2Pe 3:16 As also in all *his* epistles, speaking in them of these things; <u>in which are some things hard to be understood</u>, <u>which they that are unlearned and unstable wrest</u>, as *they do* also the other scriptures, unto their own destruction.

Commentary: Most cannot comprehend Paul. Especially when Paul goes into the depths of the mysteries – Like for instance the Three Heaven and Earth Ages.

I mean really, Yehovah wrote a love letter to his Children and his stupid foolish children snub their noses at Yehovah and refuse to study. Why with that TV there is just too much going on...

Don't you be one of those!

2Pe 3:18 But grow in grace, and *in* **the knowledge** of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. To him *be* glory both now and for ever. Amen.

Now that we have a skeleton model lets expound on it. And if we are going to speak to the Ages we must to the beginning so now on to Genesis 1.

Gen 1:1 In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth.

Commentary: Did it saw WHEN the beginning was? I grow so tired of poor ignorant Christians running around telling people the Earth is only 6k +/- years old. That is about to tell this former Civil and Environmental Engineer that those have first no knowledge of Scripture and 2nd have no knowledge of Science.

Can we establish that there is no point of Singularity that lets us set the clock as to when the beginning was? I will postulate that the Earth is Billions of years old. Let us continue.

Gen 1:2 And the earth was without form, and void; and darkness *was* upon the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God moved upon the face of the waters.

Commentary: Let us stop and consider before we continue. If this verse is true the way it is written then God is a Liar. Can God be a Liar. Yes, I know, dear reader, come with me. Remember way back when we first started at Isaiah 45? Let me bring you into rembrance.

Isa 45:18 For thus saith the LORD that created the heavens; God himself that formed the earth and made it; he hath established it, **he created it not in vain**, he formed it to be inhabited: I *am* the LORD; and *there is* none else.

Commentary: But Gen 1:2 says the earth was Tuhu va Buhoo. Well dear reader Gen 1:2 has pulled the wool over the eyes of many. But not you. If you have been confused don't be ashamed just get to work and come out of Babylon [Babel = Confusion].

The Truth can be found in that TERRIBLE mistranslation of the word "was". Lets check it out.

A primitive root (compare <u>H1933</u>); to *exist*, that is, *be* or *become*, *come to pass* (always emphatic, and not a mere copula or auxiliary): - beacon, X altogether, be (come, accomplished, committed, like), break, cause, come (to pass), continue, do, faint, fall, + follow, happen, X have, last, pertain, quit (one-) self, require, X use.

Commentary: The property translation is "And the Earth **BECAME** void and without form...."

But for now just come along on this journey thru Scripture. I promise we will get there. And why did the Earth Become void and without form? Because there was Rebellion in the first Age. And then there was a trial and there was one Son of God that was Sentenced to Death and he is known as the Son of Perdition.

Gen 1:2 And the earth was without form, and void; and darkness *was* upon the face of the deep. **And the Spirit of God moved upon the face of the waters.**

And this is where Yehovah completely threw down his creation and destroyed every living man and animal and plant in the first Age. But why would Yehovah do this? Let's now go to Revelation 12.

Rev 12:3 And there appeared another wonder in heaven; and behold a great red dragon, having seven heads and ten horns, and seven crowns upon his heads.

Commentary: Look at his Government. It is almost, but not quite identical as to the One we have today. Or rather the One that is coming.

Rev 12:4 And his tail drew the third part of the stars of heaven, and did cast them to the earth: and the dragon stood before the woman which was ready to be delivered, for to devour her child as soon as it was born.

Commentary: Now who is this Dragon? And who are these "stars of heaven"? Lets go to the Dragon first.

Rev 12:9 And the great <u>dragon</u> was cast out, **that old serpent**, called the **Devil**, and **Satan**, which deceive th the whole world: he was cast out into the earth, and his angels were cast out with him.

Commentary: I think that nails the Dragon. But check out that part about "his angels". Let the reader consider. I shall stay on point.

Let us now go to Job 38:

Job 38:1 Then the LORD answered Job out of the whirlwind, and said,

Tangent: There is very deep meaning in this verse 38:1 – cross ref 104:3; but it is not for this topic.

Job 38:2 Who is this that darkeneth counsel by words without knowledge?

Commentary: Right Yehovah has had it with foolish stupid men and women who willingly remain ignorant of his Word. We are gonna get there too.

Job 38:3 Gird up now thy loins like a man; for I will demand of thee, and answer thou me.

Commentary: This is the point where I imagine that Job's legs turned to jello.

Job 38:4 Where wast thou when I laid the foundations of the earth? declare, if thou hast understanding.

Commentary: Gen 1:1; does not give us when the Beginning was. Now How Yehovah did his fantastic works.

Job 38:5 Who hath laid the measures thereof, if thou knowest? or who hath stretched the line upon it?

Job 38:6 Whereupon are the foundations thereof fastened? or who laid the corner stone thereof;

Job 38:7 When the morning stars sang together, and all the sons of God shouted for joy?

Commentary: This is what we came for. The morning stars – Sons of God – those third drawn by the tail of that Great Dragon – Satan.

Job 38:8 Or *who* shut up the sea with doors, when it brake forth, *as if* it had issued out of the womb?

Job 38:9 When I made the cloud the garment thereof, and thick darkness a swaddlingband for it,

Job 38:10 And brake up for it my decreed *place*, and set bars and doors,

Job 38:11 And said, Hitherto shalt thou come, but no further: and here shall thy proud waves be stayed?

Commentary: Yehovah implying Can you do it Job? Yehovah fixed the Sea as he said he did in Psalm 104.

Returning to Revelation 12...

Rev 12:4 And his tail drew the third part of the stars of heaven, and did cast them to the earth: and the dragon stood before the woman which was ready to be delivered, for to devour her child as soon as it was born.

Commentary: The woman is travailing in birth to bring forth the New Age -2^{nd} Age or Flesh Age. And that Old Serpent was in that Garden. But that is another topic and I will stay on point.

Let us return now to Genesis 1.

Gen 1:28 And God blessed them, and God said unto them, Be fruitful, and multiply, and **replenish** the earth, and subdue it: and have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over every living thing that moveth upon the earth.

Commentary: The important word to pick up here is "replenish". Now Yehovah must have made a mistake Right? Why would man need to "replenish the Earth if he just created Earth and Mankind? Well now, dear reader, Yehovah does not make mistakes. Yehovah meant exactly what the Word says "Replenish". Because when the "Spirit moved" – Yehovah brought his creation to vanity and emptiness.

A primitive root, to *fill* or (intransitively) *be full* of, in a wide application (literally and figuratively): - accomplish, confirm, + consecrate, be at an end, be expired, be fenced, fill, fulfil, (be, become, X draw, give in, go) fully (-ly, -ly set, tale), [over-] flow, fulness, furnish, gather (selves, together), presume, **replenish**, satisfy, set, space, take a [hand-] full, + have wholly.

Commentary: Why the scribes got it right here and did that horrible translation at Gen 1:2 is beyond me. But let us continue. Unless you consider the possibility that Gen 1:2 is starting at the point just before the Katabole, this Age. Still the word should have been BECAME.

Now we have established the Why. Let us now go in for Substantive proof from Yehovah's Word.

Lets see what Yehovah thinks of foolish and stupid people who don't want to get around to Studying his Word. Yehovah pleads with his People.

Jer 4:1 If thou wilt return, O Israel, saith the LORD, return unto me: and if thou wilt put away thine abominations out of my sight, then shalt thou not remove.

Jer 4:22 <u>For my people *is* foolish</u>, they have not known me; <u>they are sottish</u> <u>children</u>, and they have none understanding: they *are* wise to do evil, but to do good they have no knowledge.

Commentary: The scribes were a bit kind with the word "sottish" is means downright silly, foolish and stupid.

Not my words friend.

Jer 4:23 I beheld the earth, and, lo, *it was* without form, and void; and the heavens, and they *had* no light.

Commentary: Heavens too friend. Remember friend Yehovah creates nothing without form and void. Isaiah 45. So what is this? The Spirit moved and tore up everything.

Jer 4:24 I beheld the mountains, and, lo, they trembled, and all the hills moved lightly.

Jer 4:25 I beheld, and, lo, *there was* no man, and all the birds of the heavens were fled.

Commentary: To the sceptic, who thinks this is Noah's flood. Well lets check that out. I believe there were at least 8 souls – actually many more on that Ark with Noah but what's this? There was no man? And no bird? I believe ole Noah let loose a couple two birds. Didn't he? You bet he did.

Let me take the time to make my point perfectly clear.

VERY IMPORTANT: The first Age was destroyed with Water - Noah's flood was by Water. But clearly Jeremiah cannot be talking about Noah's flood, because he looked and saw no man and no birds. Well that just can't be talking about the end of the 2nd Age. But Peter, **and this is a VERY IMPORTANT point**, Peter declares that the 2nd Age is destroyed by FIRE. So don't give me this crap that Jeremiah is talking about the 2nd Age. Then that makes Peter a Liar and the Word is annulled. I don't think so. I think that men and women wrestle with the Word.

Jer 4:26 I beheld, and, lo, <u>the fruitful place was a wilderness</u>, and all the cities thereof were broken down at the presence of the LORD, *and* by his <u>fierce anger</u>.

Commentary: And the cities – what's this? Yes sir, dear reader, there were cities in the First Age. And the Spirit MOVED- And Yehovah brought the First Age to Complete Destruction. There was not one tree standing. To those who still think this is Noah's flood – **how could you**- but nevertheless, the Dove came back with an "olive" branch, right? Yehovah Caused them to Cease existence. Void and Empty.

Why is Yehovah Angry. Come on now – catch up. Ha Satan was trying to take that Mercy Seat and he caused War and Rebellion – and Yehovah was FURIOUS. Because Satan rose to cover the mercy seat. Yehovah does not pay first. You do the Work, then Yehovah Pays. So instead of complete destruction; Yehovah planned to bring each into a 2nd Age innocent of the World that Was.

Don't you get why Yehovah was Furious with those Angels that came directly here. They taught men things man was not supposed to know – secrets of the Age that was. Those cannot receive salvation.

Jer 4:27 For thus hath the LORD said, The whole land shall be desolate; **yet will I not make a full end.**

Commentary: Remember friend, there are no Seas in the first Age. And Yehovah made the whole land desolate but Yehovah decided to grant man a Second Chance.

— "yet will I not make a full end".

2Pe 3:9 The Lord is not slack concerning his promise, as some men count slackness; **but is longsuffering to us-ward, not willing that any should perish**, but that all should come to repentance.

Commentary: Yehovah be Praised. 1/3 went with Satan. But Yehovah decided instead of complete destruction a second chance would be allowed and thus man was re-fashioned in the flesh. - The 2^{nd} Age.

Rev 21:1 And I saw a new heaven and a new earth: for the first heaven and the first earth were passed away; and there was no more sea.

Commentary: Read carefully friend. The first heaven and the first earth go not to the Age. But now we see in the Third Age – Remember Peter friend? There is no more Sea? Why no sea? Because Yehovah will reset the firmament and we shall stay here on this Great Earth forever and ever. A better translation is a "Renewed Heaven and a Renewed Earth".

Rev 21:2 And I John saw the holy city, new Jerusalem, coming down from God out of heaven, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband.

Rev 21:3 And I heard a great voice out of heaven saying, Behold, the tabernacle of God *is* with men, and he will dwell with them, and they shall be his people, and God himself shall be with them, *and be* their God.

Commentary: God comes here! Oh how I tire of the fly away doctrine.

Now lets see if we can see the model of the three Ages written into the Scriptures.

How many decks did Noah build on that Ark? Was there THREE? You bet.

Gen 6:16 A window shalt thou make to the ark, and in a cubit shalt thou finish it above; and the door of the ark shalt thou set in the side thereof; *with* lower, second, and third *stories* shalt thou make it.

Commentary: Remember that Old Dragon that Serpent – remember his Angels? Keep up friend.

Gen 6:2 That the **sons of God** saw the **daughters of men** that they *were* fair; and they took them wives of all which they chose.

Commentary: You do know what it means to take a wife – biblically speaking. I hope so.

Gen 6:5 And GOD saw that the wickedness of man *was* great in the earth, and *that* every imagination of the thoughts of his heart *was* only evil continually.

Gen 6:6 And it repented the LORD that he had made man on the earth, and it grieved him at his heart.

Commentary: Yet he Noah found favor in Yehovah; because Noah kept the Charge to keep his Pedigree pure. So that the Dragon poised to swallow up the Man Child at the Birth of the New Age would not succeed. Have you forgotten already friend – Rev 12:4. The Angels were the Second attempt to Shut down the ability to bring forth the Man Child – Yehoshuah.

Gen 6:7 And the LORD said, I will destroy man whom I have created from the face of the earth; both man, and beast, and the creeping thing, and the fowls of the air; for it repenteth me that I have made them.

Commentary: That old Dragon almost won; yet Yehovah is Long Suffering, not willing that any should perish.

Lets get some more witnesses:

Hag 2:6 For thus saith the LORD of hosts; Yet once, it *is* a little while, and I will shake the heavens, and the earth, and the sea, and the dry *land*;

Heb 12:26 Whose voice **then** shook the earth: **but now** he hath promised, saying, **Yet once more** I shake not the earth only, but also heaven.

Commentary: The end of the 2nd Age and the beginning of the 3rd.

Isa 65:17 For, behold, I create new heavens and a new earth: and the former shall not be remembered, nor come into mind.

Commentary: The end of the 2nd Age and the beginning of the 3rd.

Isa 64:1 Oh that thou wouldest rend the heavens, that thou wouldest come down, that the mountains might flow down at thy presence,

Isa 64:2 As *when* the melting fire burneth, the fire causeth the waters to boil, to make thy name known to thine adversaries, *that* the nations may tremble at thy presence!

Isa 64:3 When thou <u>didst</u> terrible things *which* we looked not for, thou camest down, the mountains flowed down at thy presence.

Commentary: And the Spirit MOVED.....and Yehovah made the Earth Tuhu va Buhoo. Void and Empty. Didst is PAST TENSE.

There are many remnants left in the physical world that are completely unexplained. Like get a look at these ruins - http://www.phenomenica.com/2008/09/tiwanaku-ruins.html

To this former Civil Engineer, the engineering ability to construct this site is PHENOMENAL. Yet instead of getting smarter thru time, the people have gotten dumber. How is this possible? I mean again the skill to build those ruins is not available today.

Now you know dear reader. Yehovah tore up all of those great building achievements save one – the pyramid. Because Yehovah promised it in his Word as a Sign to those who can READ.

Isa 19:19 In that day shall there be an altar to the LORD in the midst of the land of Egypt, and a pillar at the border thereof to the LORD.

In the beginning God created the Heaven and the Earth and then there was a falling away – apostacy – some chose to follow Satan- and Yehovah Shook the Heavens and the Earth and the Earth BECAME void and without form – uninhabitable. Then Yehovah corrected and made mankind to come thru the 2nd Age in the Flesh – to REPLENISH the Earth.

Isa 45:18 For thus saith the LORD that created the heavens; God himself that formed the earth and made it; he hath established it, **he created it not in vain**, he formed it to be inhabited: I *am* the LORD; and *there is* none else.

He created it NOT destroyed. Yehovah does not build a wasteland.

And as Peter so eloquenty wrote – at the End of this Age again there will be a Great Apostacy – and Yehovah will yet shake the Heaven and the Earth yet again. And we shall be transformed and we shall enter the 3rd Age.

Stay on Scripture and do not learn to lean on man. Do not trust this man or anything that I have written. If you refuse to go and check behind me and this writing then you may as well throw this in the garbage.

Now to those who carry on about re-incarnation. Yehovah's Word does not support it. We will come thru this Age ONE time and then to the Judgment. We will each go thru Age -1^{st} and 2^{nd} but only those who overcome will go thru the 3^{rd} .

Yehovah himself came thru this Age in the flesh in the body of Yehoshuah. Yehovah Saves! Praise Yehovah. Yehovah Leads by Example. It is not hard to follow that type of Leader.

Heb 2:14 Forasmuch then as the children are partakers of flesh and blood, he also himself likewise took part of the same; that through death he might destroy him that had the power of death, that is, the devil;

What do you think it takes to kill one of your own Children? Satan was a son of God. "Yet, I will not make a full end" – a new age -2^{nd} .

More References: Remember that Greek Word "katabole" – to throw down – make waste?

Lets see if the writers of the New Testament were aware of this Katabole: These references elude to the Restoration of the World as documented in Gen 1 and Gen 2.

From <u>G2598</u>; a *deposition*, that is, *founding*; figuratively *conception*: - conceive, **foundation**.

Matt 13:35

35 That it might be fulfilled which was spoken by the prophet, saying, I will open my mouth in parables; I will utter things which have been kept secret from the **foundation** of the world.

Matt 25:34

34 Then shall the King say unto them on his right hand, Come, ye blessed of my Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the **foundation** of the world:

Luke 11:50

50 That the blood of all the prophets, which was shed from the **foundation** of the world, may be required of this generation;

John 17:24

24 Father, I will that they also, whom thou hast given me, be with me where I am; that they may behold my glory, which thou hast given me: for thou lovedst me

before the **foundation** of the world.

Eph 1:4

4 According as he hath chosen us in him before the **foundation** of the world, that we should be holy and without blame before him in love:

Heb 4:3

3 For we which have believed do enter into rest, as he said, As I have sworn in my wrath, if they shall enter into my rest: although the works were finished from the **foundation** of the world.

Heb 9:26

26 For then must he often have suffered since the **foundation** of the world: but now once in the end of the world hath he appeared to put away sin by the sacrifice of himself.

Heb 11:11 (THIS ONE IS INTERESTING!)

11 Through faith also Sara herself received strength to **conceive** seed, and was delivered of a child when she was past age, because she judged him faithful who had promised.

1 Pet 1:20

20 Who verily was foreordained before the **foundation** of the world, but was manifest in these last times for you,

Rev 13:8

8 And all that dwell upon the earth shall worship him, whose names are not written in the book of life of the Lamb slain from the **foundation** of the world.

Rev 17:8

8 The beast that thou sawest was, and is not; and shall ascend out of the bottomless pit, and go into perdition: and they that dwell on the earth shall wonder, whose names were not written in the book of life from the **foundation** of the world, when they behold the beast that was, and is not, and yet is.

To arrive at the true meaning of this expression, we must note that there are two words translated "foundation" in the New Testament: (1) *themelios*, and (2) *katabole*.

The Noun, *themelios*, occurs in Luke 6:48-49, 14:29, Acts 16:26, Romans 15:20, 1Corinthians 3:10-12, Ephesians 2:20, 1Timothy 6:19, 2Timothy 2:19, Hebrews 6:1, 11:10, Revelation 21:14,19. It is never used of the world (*kosmos*) or the earth (*ge*). The corresponding Verb (*themelioo*) occurs in Matthew 7:25, Luke 6:48, Ephesians 3:17, Colossians 1:23, Hebrews 1:10 and 1Peter 5:10. The verb is only once used of the earth (*ge*). Hebrews 1:10.

A comparison of all these passages will show that these are proper and regular terms for the English words "to found", and "foundation".

The Noun, *katabole*, occurs in Matthew 13:35, 25:34, Luke 11:50, John 17:24, Ephesians 1:4, Hebrews 4:3, 9:26, 11:11, 1Peter 1:20, Revelation 13:8, 17:8 and the corresponding Verb (*kataballo*) occurs in 2Corinthians 4:9, Hebrews 6:1 and Revelation 12:10.

A comparison of all these passages (especially 2Corinthians 4:9 and Revelation 12:10) will show that *kataballo* and *katabole* are not the proper terms for founding and foundation, but the correct meaning is *casting down*, or *overthrow*.

Consistency, therefore, calls for the same translation in Hebrews 6:1, where, instead of "not laying again", the rendering should be "not casting down". That is to say, the foundation already laid, of repentance, etc., was not to be cast down or overthrown, but was to be *left* and progress made unto the perfection.

Accordingly, the Noun *katabole*, derived from, and cognate with the Verb, ought to be translated "disruption", or "ruin".

The remarkable thing is that in all occurrences (except Hebrews 11:11) the word is connected with "the world" (Greek *kosmos*. Appendix 129.1), and therefore the expression should be rendered "the disruption (or ruin) of the world", clearly referring to the condition indicated in Genesis 1:2, and described in 2Peter 3:5-6. For the earth was not created *tohu* (Isaiah 45:18) but *became* so, as stated in the Hebrew of Genesis 1:2 and confirmed by 2Peter 3:6, where "the world that then was by the word of God" (Genesis 1:1) perished and "the heavens and the earth which are now, by the same word" were created (Genesis 2:4), and are "kept in store, reserved unto fire against the day of judgment" (2Peter 3:7) which shall usher in the "new heavens and the new earth" of 2Peter 3:13.

"The disruption of the world" is an event forming a great dividing line in the dispensations of the ages. In Genesis 1:1 we have the *founding* of the world (Hebrews 1:10 = themelioo), but in Genesis 1:2 we have its *overthrow*.

This is confirmed by a further remarkable fact, that the phrase, which occurs ten times, is associated with the Preposition *apo* = from (Appendix 104. iv) seven times, and with *pro* = before (Appendix 104. xiv) three times. The former refers to the *kingdom*, and is connected with the "counsels" of God; the latter refers to the Mystery (or Secret; See Appendix 193) and is connected with the "purpose" of God (see John 17:24, Ephesians 1:4, 1Peter 1:20).

Ample New Testament testimony is thus given to the profoundly significant fact recorded in Genesis 1:2, that "the earth became *tohu* and *bohu* (i.e. waste end desolate); and darkness was on the face of the deep", before the creation of "the heavens and the earth which are now" (2Peter 3:7).
